International Schools' Assessment (ISA) results



The ISA is an annual assessment programme specially developed to measure the skills of students studying the International Baccalaureate (IB), in subject the areas of mathematical literacy, reading and writing. ISA is based on the internationally endorsed reading and mathematical literacy frameworks of the Programme for International Student Assessment (PISA). ISA reports provide descriptive information about what students know and can do.

Like most schools who take the ISA, we have done so for the purposes of international comparison. This means we are widely regarded as a 1st Tier school, with students who have elevated levels of student achievement.


